

MIRACLE 1000 SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION

Miracle 1000 Scholarships are given in the honor of great servant leaders such as Abraham Lincoln, Martin Luther King Jr., Mother Teresa, Harriet Tubman, and Nelson Mandela. Scholarships are awarded based on <u>merit</u> (not necessarily on financial need). Applicants for this scholarship must display a strong desire to be a servant leader.

Qualities of a true servant leader:

-Influences others to be better people; to be more honest, disciplined, confident, and generous.
-Is more interested in serving than being served.
-Exemplifies a sense of humility and understanding.
-Dedication to personal growth, learning new life skills, and to impact the world in a positive way.

This is an essential skill to develop in becoming a leader. You are encouraged to reach out and motivate your peers and be the best you can be! Your friend can also apply for a Miracle Scholarship.
